



### **Farm Animal Matching Game**

1. Print or draw two sets of farm animal images (they should be identical as this is a matching game). Feel free to use the animals above, just copy and paste them into a Word document and enlarge them.
2. Match the animals together with your children so they see the matches for each animal.
3. Next, hand your children two different animals and have them leave the room while you hide the matching animals.
4. Have your children come back into the room and look for their animal matches, using the animal images in their hand to help guide them to their match.
5. You can play again and keep adding more animals to find/match. To make it easier you can tape the animals on the wall for your children to find.
6. For additional fun you can play the Old MacDonald song in the background while playing the animal matching game.

### **Old MacDonald Animal Musical Chairs**

Tape a different farm animal image on at least three chairs and use up to six chairs if playing with multiple siblings. Play the Old MacDonald song and hand your children one farm animal image each. When the music stops have them find the chair with the matching animal and sit in it. Siblings can work together and/or parents can model the activity and work with their toddler aged children to find the right spot if needed. When the music starts give them a new animal and have them play again. You can also place the animals on pillows on the carpet or designated areas on the ground to play if you don't want to use chairs.

### **Old MacDonald Freeze Dance**

Play the Old MacDonald Song and stop/start it. Move around and dance with your children until the music stops, then freeze, until the music starts again.

### **Animal Nature Walk**

Grab your homemade binoculars and go outside with your children. See how many animals you can spot with them. If you have any play animals to hide you could place them outdoors ahead of time and let your children "find them" in the yard.
