For our Creative Caterpillars:

1) Egg carton caterpillar:

Cut one side of an egg carton along its length. Use your choice of color to paint your caterpillar. Give it some eyes using a marker and antennae using pipe cleaners or twigs from the yard.



2) Butterfly symmetry smash art:

Butterflies are a fun way to learn symmetry. Cut out butterflies from construction paper by folding it in half. Children can then squirt paint or pour a spoonful of different color paints on one side of the folded paper butterfly, fold it together and smash it. When they open the butterfly, it will be the same on both sides. Once it dries, children can add antenna gluing some black paper or pipe cleaners.

Science & sensory activities for our Beautiful Butterflies:

1) Playdough caterpillar:

Make your own caterpillar using playdough.

2) Coffee filter Butterfly:

Children can use markers to draw on the coffee filter. Spray water on them and watch how the colors spread and mix. Once dry, pinch the coffee filter in the middle and secure it with a pipe cleaner/clothes pin to make a beautiful butterfly.
