## **Creative**

If available add some eyes to it.

### Thumbprint ants

Use black paint to make a thumb print on paper. Add legs with a marker or crayons.



## **Sensory /Math /Cooking**

### Edible bug snack

#### Ingredients

1 slice of bread

Circle shape cookie cutter or any circular object.

Strawberry jelly to spread on the bread

A small box of raisins

Use a slice of bread and cut it using a circle cookie cutter.

Talk to children about the shape being used and the shape of a ladybug i.e. Circle.

Have children spread the jelly over the bread with limited help.

Have children count five raisins from the box and to put on the jelly.

In order to extend their learning experience add/take out a few raisins.
