Art Activities:

- Paper Plate flowers – using a paper plate have the children cut the sides with scissors. This way it can make marks on the sides to look like the petals. Have the children use paint or markers and /or crayons. Using green paper have the children create a stem and leaves.
- Nature Binoculars- glue together two toilet paper tubes together so they are side by side. Encourage the children to decorate their binoculars using either crayons or markers and stickers if you have. While on your nature walk have the children use their binoculars to see all the spring things in your neighborhood.
- Painting with nature – Encourage the children to gather leaves or flowers from the yard. Have the children dip them into paint and use their leaf or flower as a paintbrush. Have the children hang up their artwork at their eye level. The child will be happy to share their art with other family members. Have the children put on an art show with all their work to other relatives or their friends using with zoom or facetime.
- Nature walk bracelet – Loosely wrap a piece of masking tape around the child's wrist with the sticky side out. While you are playing outside or taking a walk have the children stick on the tape the items, they found to create a beautiful bracelet.
